Executive Summary

Report on First Destinations of VMI Graduates from the 2020-2021 Academic Year

Context

Annually, the Office of Career Services (OCS) investigates the first destination career status of graduates receiving degrees during the previous 12 months.

The target population, referred to herein as the OCS Cohort, comprised all 412 graduates who were awarded degrees between September 2020 and May 2021. Data were collected by the OCS from Institute offices and individual graduates.

Key Findings

Commissioning

242 (59%) graduates were commissioned, with 239 in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Included among the commissioned graduates were 3 foreign cadets, 2 from the Republic of China

Employment

Graduates continue to be very successful in a competitive employment market.

The percentage of graduates seeking employment as of 31 October is remarkably low: <1%.
