

- B. New Cadets on ROTC Contract. New Cadets who hold ROTC scholarships are discouraged from seeking ROTC re-affiliation as they will incur the loss of their scholarships in the process.
- C. New Cadets not on ROTC Contract. ROTC re-affiliation is most appropriate for New

- 1) Second and First Class cadets may voluntarily change their ROTC affiliation to the Army ROTC program. See paragraph 9 for details.
- 2) Second and First Class cadets may pursue a commission through one of the following non-ROTC programs: U.S. Marine Corps Platoon Leaders Class (PLC), U.S. Navy Officer Candidate School (OCS), and the U.S. Coast Guard Direct Commission Selected School (DCSS) program.
- 3) Second and First Class cadets who are contracted with or actively pursuing a commission through non-ROTC programs
